The BCP Suite includes a training session for developing continuity plans, automated continuity and disaster recovery plan generators, and a self-directed exercise that can assist in testing the efficacy of your plan.
- *Active Shooter Training* – Do your employees know how to respond in the event of an attack? The Active Shooter Training Program is designed to assist business owners and operators in preparing personnel on how to respond in such an incident.
- *Training and Exercises* – DHS provides numerous training opportunities that can assist in developing preparedness and response efforts, and this segment will provide more information on those courses and programs.

Cybersecurity Awareness: Topics provide background information about reviewing cyber resilience capabilities, improving information sharing, and evaluating security needs for protecting national cyber assets:

- *Cybersecurity and Communications Programs* – How secure are your networks? The CRR offers a voluntary and no-cost evaluation of an organization's operational resilience and cyber risk management capabilities, while the *Cyber Security Evaluation Tool (CSET)* offers a systematic, repeatable approach for assessing the security posture of a cyber system or network.
- *Homeland Security Information Network* — Critical Infrastructure (HSIN-CI) – Short on information? HSIN-CI is a secure, unclassified Web-based communications system that is a primary means of sharing sensitive, unclassified information.
- *Federal Bureau of Investigation Presentation* – As part of Cybersecurity Awareness Month, the FBI will provide an overview of the cyber programs made available by the Bureau.

Critical Infrastructure Security and Resilience: Topics focus on tools and resources for improving the overall security of a critical infrastructure asset or facility:

- *Office of Bombing Prevention (OBP): IED Awareness/Bomb Threat Management* – Want to improve your ability to manage IED threats? OBP can help you highlight specific safety precautions associated with explosive incidents and bomb threats.
- *Infrastructure Survey Tools and Dashboards* – Looking for an outsider's perspective on your security? DHS Protective Security Advisors will assess your facility's security posture, and then provide you with the results via its interactive "Dashboards" program.
- *National Infrastructure Coordinating Center (NICC)* – Seeking incident and threat notifications? The NICC is the information and coordination hub of a national network dedicated to protecting critical infrastructure, and offers notifications, SARS, incident-related information, and daily open-source reports.
